

his phone number is 912-265-9591. They are \$105 and made of stainless steel (see picture). You need to get your ring sized correctly before calling him. With the stainless steel, they are not adjustable after they are struck. We do have a ring sizer in the display case if you need to know what size you are.


EASTERN STAR




